Friday 21st March is not only Red Nose Day for Comic Relief but also World Down Syndrome Day as well and Easthorpe Student Council have been very busy making plans for all pupils to show their support to both causes.

In aid of Comic Relief, they have agreed that they would like everyone to participate in a sponsored run/walk (3km & 5km). The children have been busy measuring out the perimeter of the track on the field and we will be doing the run/walk over a period of 5 days. This will take place during break times and PE lessons from Friday 14th March onwards.
